



### Memorandum of Understanding


This Memorandum of Understanding is signed on September 22, 2016 between Governor Sindh and Transparency International, Pakistan for the establishment of **Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee (CCLC)**.

The Governor Sindh is desirous to address the menace of corruption in the Province of Sindh. Transparency International agreed to support the Governor in his aim to eradicate corruption from Sindh Province.

By signing this MOU, both parties hereby agree:

- Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee shall be an independent body set up at the Governor Sindh's House.
- Five Members of Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee shall be nominated from the Civil society by the Governor, including a representative of Transparency International Pakistan, nominated by Chairman TI Pakistan.
- Chairman of Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee shall be nominated by the Governor for the tenure of two years.
- Sindh Anti-corruption Hotline shall be set up by Transparency International Pakistan under the Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee.
- The office of Sindh Anti-corruption Hotline including the furniture, staff and all logistics will be provided and financed by the Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee.
- Sindh Anti-Corruption Hotline shall initially be operated by Transparency International Pakistan for a period of one year and shall be subsequently run by Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee experts.
- Ordinance/Act for the formulation of Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee shall be the responsibility of the Governor Sindh.
- Transparency International, Pakistan shall provide its services free of cost and shall not be part of any decision making by Citizen's Corruption Liaison Committee.
