G/2010 Application by Syed Adil Gilani, Chairman Transparency International Pakistan**

Honourable Chief Justice,

The above referred Human Right Cases No 18567-S/2010 + HRC 3379-S/2010+ HRC 22387 are sub-juice. However on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2010, Express Group of Newspapers, in "The Express Tribune" in English, and "Daily Express" in Urdu published the following misleading headlines.

**"Behind-the-scenes deal uncovered" and**

The copies of the news reported are attached.

The news papers has reported as follows,

*"The detained chairman, Ayaz Khan Niazi, has revealed that the top guns of Transparency International (TI), Pakistan, had offered to help him clear his name in corruption cases presently with the Supreme Court, if he signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to award all lucrative contracts on their recommendation in the future.*

*An absconding NICL board member, Qasim Amin Dada, wanted by the FIA in this same Rs4 billion land scam, tried to convince his colleagues to strike a deal with TI representatives, according to Niazi.*



*TI volunteered to present a fact-finding report to the SC establishing the innocence of NICL officials. In return NICL would award contracts solely to private parties cleared by TI and advertise tenders in newspapers after referring to the agency for advice."*

The news report portrays the impression that the supreme court can be influenced by any one.

This Group of Newspaper have in the past been involved in vilification campaign TI, TI Pakistan and its Chairman, in its TV Channel. TI Pakistan has sued the Anchor and the Newspaper for defamation of character of the undersigned and credibility and reputation of Transparency International Pakistan, in the Sindh High Court. The SHC has issued notices to the respondents.


Mr. Sohail Muzaffar, Attorney, who is also a Trustee of TI Pakistan has issued legal notices to the News Correspondent and Chief Editor of the Express Tribune on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2010, for publishing the following

*" Therefore you publish the like news in your paper without verifying the facts and thus attempted to malign Mr. Adil Gilani as well as Transparency International before general public as well as government functionaries and the Honorable Apex Court".*

Copies of the legal notices are attached.

It is prayed that the media be directed to abstain from publishing any un-substantiated allegation against TI, TI Pakistan and its Chairman, till the case is decided by the Supreme Court.
