**Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Deputy Director (Technical), Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation's Notice for Pre-Qualification of Consultants.**

Dear Sir,

The Deputy Director (Technical), Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation's Notice for Pre-Qualification of Consultants, published in daily "Jang" on October 06, 2012, is against the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

TI-Pakistan would like to point out that Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation has not mentioned anything about the pre-qualification documents to be collected by the bidders. This act of Federal Government Employees Housing Foundation is in violation of Rule 16(2) of the Public Procurement Rules 2004. The Rule is quoted below for your information;

*16:- Pre-qualification process:- (2) The procuring agency shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.*


*Explanation.-For the purposes of this sub-rule price means the cost of printing and providing the documents only..*

TI-Pakistan would also like to refer PPRA notification No. F.2 (9)/DD-II/PPRA/2009 dated 7<sup>th</sup> July 2009, which confirms TI-P views.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

- xiii. Participating consultant must have valid professional indemnity insurance.
- xiv. Participation consultant must be certified for ISO 9001 and ISO 18001.
