Dear Sir,

The Pakistan Housing Authority, Islamabad's expression of interest notice for purchase of 30 acres land in zone IV Islamabad, published in daily "Dawn" on 03<sup>rd</sup> November 2011, is against the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

The Pakistan Housing Authority has made no mention about the pre-qualification documents or bidding documents to be collected by bidders, which is a violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004. The rules are stated below for your information;

- 16. Pre-qualification process.- (2) The procuring agency shall provide a set of prequalification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.
- **23.** Bidding documents.— (1) Procuring agencies shall formulate precise and unambiguous bidding documents that shall be made available to the bidders immediately after the publication of the invitation to bid.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures.

TI-Pakistan would also like to inform the Minister that NICL Mega Corruption Case was exposed on violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 in a similar Prequalification Notice for 100 acres land, which was not published on PPRA website and violated Rule No.13. The Supreme Court of Pakistan took suo moto notice of TI-P letter of May 2009 and initiated the suo moto case 18 of 2010.

TI Pakistan is striving to have Rule of Law in Pakistan.
