VIOLATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES 2004, SR. JOINT DIRECTOR (CIVIL), CIVIL (WORKS) DIVISION MULTAN, MULTAN INT'L. AIRPORT, MULTAN'S TENDER NOTICE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BARRACK ACCOMMODATION FOR ASF PERSONNEL AT MULTAN INT'L AIRPORT

Dear Sir,

Reference is invited to your letter No.TL15/027/2A dated 2nd July, 2015 (copy enclosed for ready reference) regarding the subject matter.

2. With regard, your goodself is apprised that the said Tender Notice has been got issued in the press publication by this office as per prevalent policy of Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority (PCAA) in line with the PPRA Rules and as such no violation of any of the PPRA Rules specifically PPRA Rules 2004, Rule 28(1) as highlighted by your goodself has been done.

3. It is also apprised that PCAA has a set mechanism, based on Accountability, for the publication of Tender Notice, wherein, this office is only bound to initiate / submit the Tender Notice for publication to Public Relation Section, HQCAA and, thereafter, the Tender Notice is got issued by the concerned section at HQCAA strictly in accordance with the PPRA Rules and as such no breach of PPRA Rules is possible as the Tender Notice passes through the sieve of Accountability.

4. To further clarify the stance of this office enclosed find a Policy letter No. HQCAA/5177/PR dated 13th July, 2012 issued directly with the signature of the then Honorable DGCAA which clearly address your goodself contention. The Tender Notices of PCAA all across Pakistan have been got issued on the same pattern / specimen as defined by HQCAA from July, 2012 but till date no query from your good office or any other corner has come to the notice of this office regarding breach of any PPRA Rules during this long period of 3 years, wherein, thousands and thousands of the Tender Notices on the same set pattern have been got issued by PCAA.

5. The complete details for the said tender as defined / required by PPRA Rule 28(1) and highlighted by your goodself has been provided in the Tender Notice uploaded publically on websites of PCAA and PPRA (copy enclosed) and the same has been clearly mentioned in the Newspaper, the cutting of which has been attached with the above-referred letter of your goodself and as such no breach of the PPRA Rule 28(1) has been made and the same may be appreciated by your goodself.

6. Concluding, it is apprised that the breach of PPRA Rule 28(1) has not been made. However, if, still your good office has any queries regarding the subject matter, the same may be taken up with HQCAA since the same does not come under the purview of this office.

Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Sr. Joint Director (Civil), Civil (Works) Division Multan, Multan International Airport, Multan's Tender Notice for Construction of Barrack Accommodation for ASF Personnel at Multan International Airport.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Multan International Airport, Multan's Tender Notice published in daily "The Nation" on 28th June, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

As per advertisement, only the date and time for opening of tender is mentioned without stating the last date and time of submission of tender that shall also be on the same day. It is violation of PPRA 2004, Rule 28(1). Stated as under;

28. Opening of bids. – (1) The date for opening of bids and the last date for the submission of bids shall be the same. Bids shall be opened at the time specified in the bidding documents. The bids shall be opened at least thirty minutes after the deadline for submission of bids.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

5. To ensure timely publications, advertisement material should reach Public Relations Branch, HQCAA, ten (10) days prior to the proposed date of publication.
