Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Director (Commercial & Estates), Civil Aviation Authority, Karachi's Tender Notices for Supply, Installation and Operation of Common use Passenger Processing System (CUPPS).

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Civil Aviation Authority, Karachi's Tender Notices published in daily "The News" on 15th July, 2016,. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

The fee for the RFP documents is charged as PRs 10,000/- in the advertisement, which appears costly in light of the Public Procurement Rules 2004. Stated as under;


25. Bidding documents. – (5) The procuring agency shall provide a set of bidding documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.

Explanation - For the purpose of this sub-rule price means the cost of printing and providing the documents only.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tenders under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Bids are invited on a single stage two envelope basis i.e. Technical and Financial Offer from reputable and renowned companies having good reputation and sound financial background. Bidders(s) must secure 80% weightage in their Technical Offer to become 'Technically qualified'. Financial offers of only Technically Qualified firms would be opened. The concession shall be awarded for a period of 5 years.

Defaulter of CAA dues are not eligible to apply. Late, ambiguous and / or conditional submissions shall not be entertained.
