Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 Cantonment Board Karachi Re-Tender
Notice

Dear Sir,

The Cantonment Board Karachi re-tender notice for the outsourcing of Conservancy Services within KCB Areas, published in daily Dawn on 13th December 2010, is against the Public Procurement Rules 2004, as minimum period of 15 days are mandatory to submit applications from the date of publication of advertisement notice in press, whereas you have given only 8 days, which is a violation of rules. Rule is quoted below for your information;

13. Response time.-


The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures.

TIP would like to quote Supreme Court Order given on 28th April 2010, in the case of award of multibillion dollar LNG contract to GDF-Suez, in which the SC has announced that it is the duty of the Court to ensure the application of Public Procurement Rules 2004.

RE-TENDER NOTICE

OUTSOURCING OF CONSERVANCY SERVICES WITHIN KCB AREAS

1. Tenders are invited from well established and reputed conservancy service providers/firms having a minimum experience of 05 years in Solid Waste Management practices / skills for award of the contract of conservancy services in Karachi Cantonment. This contract will be awarded for the terms **January 01, 2011 to June 30, 2011** and **July 01, 2011 to June 30, 2012** and may be conditionally renewed for the second term on satisfactory performance. The tenders consisting of two separate envelopes marked "Technical" & "Financial" separately, with full details, complete in all respects must reach the undersigned before/on **December 20, 2010**.
2. The Technical Proposal will be evaluated mainly on the basis of strict criteria keeping in view of the following and, financial bids of only those firms/contractors will be opened who are selected as technically responsive/viable. Otherwise sealed financial envelope of technically non-responsive firms/service providers will be returned accordingly:
 - a) Firm's Business Profile with permanent and present mailing address.
 - b) NTN Number, Income Tax clearance certificate for the last three years.
 - c) Financial status, Banker's reference, detail of capital investment position, total value of assets, liabilities.
 - d) Convincing proofs for Technical & Financial capability to undertake and perform the contractual obligations.
 - e) Detail of past contracts and current contracts along with satisfactory performance report from the concerned departments/agencies/bodies.
 - f) Detail of machinery & equipment with specifications mentioned above owned by the firm or leased by the firm with proof of their attested copies of registration books.
 - g) Detail of technically qualified and skilled staff for the operation/maintenance.
3. **Area of responsibility:** Whole area of Karachi Cantonment.
4. **Required Equipment and Manpower:** The service provider will deploy the optimum resources on every working day in the area of responsibility and shall submit details of the manpower and machinery he has to employ/rely on for satisfactory performance of the contractual obligations.
5. The Firm/Service Provider shall enclose a sum of **Rs.500,000/- (Rupees Five Lac only)** as Earnest Money in the shape of Pay Order in the name of Executive Officer, Karachi Cantl. Board.
6. The Firm/Service Provider shall quote the rates in terms of lump sum amount per month for all the works as enumerated in the tender documents.
7. Physical inspection of equipment in working and functional condition will be carried out by the KCB before awarding the contract.
8. Affidavit of Firm/Service Provider to the extent of not being black listed and not being involved in litigation with any Govt. department.
9. The successful Firm/Service Provider will be required to execute an agreement with KCB on a judicial stamp paper of appropriate value within 07 days of communication of approval of his rates.
10. Firm/Service Provider shall maintain his own workshop for quick repairs and maintenance of vehicles, machinery, equipment, etc.
11. Tender Form, along with the detailed scope of works, manpower/machinery/equipment, etc. and terms and conditions of contract, can be obtained from the office of the KCB, situated at 259, Sarwar Shaheed Road, Karachi, during office hours on any working day on payment of **Rs.10,000/- (non-refundable)**.
12. KCB or the Executive Officer reserve the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.
