Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Cantonment Executive Officer, Cantonment Board Malir, Karachi's Pre- Qualification Notice for Dualization of Roads & Landscaping Consultants.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Cantonment Board Malir, Karachi's Pre- Qualification Notice published in daily "The News" on 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per the advertisement, "no pre-qualification document is issued for the bidders and it has only mentioned that for any queries and details regarding the mentioned work, contact the undersigned ", whereas according to Rule No. 16 (1) (2) it is mandatory to provide a set of prequalification document, and provide detail evaluation criteria to applicants. The Rule is quoted below for your information;

**16. Pre-qualification process.-** (1) *The procuring agency engaging in pre-qualification shall announce, in the pre-qualification documents, all information required for pre-qualification including instructions for preparation and submission of the pre-qualification documents, evaluation criteria, list of documentary evidence required by suppliers or contractors to demonstrate their respective qualifications and any other information that the procuring agency deems necessary for pre-qualification.*

(2) *The procuring agency shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.*

Transparency International Pakistan would also like to refer PPRA notification No. F.2 (9)/DD-II/PPRA/2009 dated 7<sup>th</sup> July 2009 (Copy Enclosed).

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the pre-qualification notice under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and provide evaluation criteria and extend date accordingly.

Subject: IMPLEMENTATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004

My dear

Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) works through PPRA Ordinance, 2002 and Rules notified in 2004 to improve governance, management, transparency, accountability and quality of public procurement of goods, services and works.

2. Violations of Rule-16 by procuring agencies have been reported numerously at the time of prequalification notices published in the print media for the selection of bidders. To refresh, Rule-16 provides:

1. The procuring agency engaging in pre-qualification shall announce, in the pre-qualification documents, all information required for pre-qualification including instructions for preparation and submission of the pre-qualification documents, evaluation criteria, list of documentary evidence required by suppliers or contractors to demonstrate their respective qualifications and any other information that the procuring agency deems necessary for pre-qualification.
2. The procuring agency shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.

*Explanation:-* For the purposes of this sub-rule price means the cost of printing and providing the documents only.
