**Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Cantonment Board, Pano Aqil,
Tender Notice for construction work.**

Dear Sir,

The Cantonment Board, Pano Aqil's tender notice for construction work, published in daily "Dawn" on 26th December 2011, is against the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

A minimum period of 15 days is mandatory to submit applications from the date of publication of advertisement notice in press, whereas Cantonment Board, Pano Aqil has given only 04 days, which is a violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004. The Rule is quoted below for your information;

13. Response time.- *The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.*

Ministry of Defence has also taken serious notice of Public Procurement Rules 2004 violations. In this regard, TI-Pakistan refers to Ministry of Defence's letter No 2/2/D-18/2009 dated January 31st 2011 (enclosed), which states that "the PPRA Rules must be observed in their perspective in letter & spirit while making procurements. Violation of those rules will be viewed seriously and Head of Department/Organisation will be held responsible for the same."

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures.

DESIRABLE MINIMUM INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED IN TENDER NOTICE THROUGH PRESS

1. Name of procuring agency.
2. Tender number (for identification)
3. Procurement Title (indicating type and quantity).
4. Contact person (for seeking bidding documents).
5. Last date for obtaining bidding documents and its price (if any).
6. Closing time and date as well as place for receiving bids.
7. Time and Place of public opening of bids (Bids must be opened on the closing date).
8. Amount of bid security (%age of bid price or lumpsum).
9. Time period for performance of contract.

This has been viewed with concern by the Principal Accounting Officer i.e. Secretary Defence.

3. The Public Accounts Committee vide their letter No.F.1(1)2010-PAC, dated 21-06-2010 made similar observations.

4. It is reiterated that the PPRA Rules must be observed in their true perspective in letter & spirit while making procurements. Violation of those rules will be viewed seriously and Head of Department/Organization will be held responsible for the same.
