Dear Sir,

The Director, Environment Protection Directorate, Capital Development Authority, Islamabad's expression of interest notice for licensing/renting of nursery plots, published in daily "Express" and "Dawn" on 20th October 2011, is against the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

The Capital Development Authority has made no mention about the pre-qualification documents or bidding documents to be collected by bidders, which is a violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004. The rules are stated below for your information;

16. Pre-qualification process.- (2) The procuring agency shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.

23. Bidding documents.- (1) Procuring agencies shall formulate precise and unambiguous bidding documents that shall be made available to the bidders immediately after the publication of the invitation to bid.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures.
