Subject: Complaint against Tendering procedures of CDGK: NIT No EDO/W&S/CDGK/S-
II/177/10 dated 29 April 2010

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan refers to the meeting on the held at your office and under your convener ship, on Tuesday 8 July 2010, where experts from PPRA, and EDO Works & Services were also present.

Following was agreed in the meeting:

1. For all procurements of Road, Bridges, Sewage, Drainage, Building and Services, only Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure shall be used by CDGK.
2. In the present procurements, CDGK was recommended to discharge the tenders and reinvite tenders, with amended prequalification documents and tenders at the same time. But on insistence CDGK, that the Technical Evaluation may be considered as prequalification, and CDGK may be allowed by PPRA to process the prequalification of submitted bids, it was agreed that CDGK may be allowed this time only, and in all future tenders CDGK will invite Works Tender on Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure.
3. CDGK will evaluate all firms in present tendering of 5 projects, based on the Evaluation Criteria as detailed in the Technical Evaluation Form, including the vital criteria that the firms shall be license holder in both Civil & Electrical Categories of PEC and Each of the Joint Venture partner shall be evaluated on their own merit, and shall be able of qualify as an individual firm, filing which the JV stand disqualified.
4. That the engineers identified on the PEC License of the firms shall be in the continued service of the firm for last 12 months, for which FBR paid tax receipts of the salaries of such engineers for each month shall be examined and verified by the evaluation committee.
5. In case of failure of any firm in this criteria, the firm's license shall be reported to PEC for cancellation of the license under PEC byelaw No. 8 of the Construction and Operation of Engineering Works Bye-laws, 1987.

The evaluation reports of the prequalification as agreed above, will be submitted to the MD PPRA by 20th July 2010 and a meeting of PPRA and TIP will be held to examine the evaluation reports.
