

VIOLATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004, CITY DISTRICT GOVERNMENT, RAWALPINDI, QUOTATION NOTICE.

I am enclosing herewith a letter received from the Chairman, Transparency International-Pakistan, with the mention that an advertisement released by you, published in Daily Express dated 09-10-2010, is against the Public Procurement Rules, 2004, as against the mandatory provision of a minimum period of 15 days, for receiving of applications/quotations, a period of only 12 days has been prescribed in the advertisement, which is contrary to and violation of Public Procurement Rules, 2004.

It has further been observed, after perusal of your office file, that according to your office reports, you had completed all the codal formalities including uploading the advertisement at website of the PEPRA but the irregularity/short coming pointed out in the enclosed letter, depicts the careless attitude on your part.

You are, therefore, directed to take immediate legal steps; for getting the advertisement published, strictly according to the Rules, prescribed procedure and explain the reasons of above mentioned situation within 2 days, positively.
