Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has not received any response to its letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> August, regarding complaints on the contracts awarded in the Department of Parks and Horticulture, City District Government Karachi.

On 1<sup>st</sup> June 2009, DCO CDGK also sent you TI Pakistan reminder dated 26<sup>th</sup> May 2009, in which you were directed by the DCO to provide the following information in compliance to the Public Procurement Rule 2004, Rule, to TI Pakistan on priority basis;

All Contracts Contract Agreements of over Rs. 10 million, and the Evaluation Reports, Integrity Pact and PPRA Evaluation Form shall be posted on CDGK website.

TI Pakistan again request you to kindly provide these information so that the allegations could be checked from the procurement process followed by CDGK in award of Contracts or not. This is to note that DCO has also ordered you to send the required information to TI Pakistan, and failure to do so may strengthen the correctness of the allegations of mis-procurement, which comes under Public Procurement Rule 2004, Rule 2 (f) "corrupt and fraudulent practices" which states;

*" includes the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value to influence the action of a public official or the supplier or contractor in the procurement process or in contract execution to the detriment of the procuring agencies; or misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract, collusive practices among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels and to deprive the procuring agencies of the benefits of free and open competition and any request for, or solicitation of anything of value by any public official in the course of the exercise of his duty"*
