**SUBJECT: VIOLATION OF SINDH PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES 2010 IN  
THE TENDER NOTICE FOR "BANARAS AT GRADE WORKS"  
AMOUNTING TO RS 600.00 MILLION.**

I am directed to refer to letter No. Nil dated 23-05-21011 addressed to the Administrator, CDGK from the Executive Director, Transparency International, Pakistan (copy enclosed) and to state as under:

It is informed in the above referred letter that Transparency International, Pakistan has received a complaint wherein following allegations have been made:-

- i. The Executive District Officer (W&S) CDGK has awarded a contract for "Banaras at Grade Works" to M/s. Naseeb Khan & Brothers without following the procedure required by Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010. This is a violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 and Rule 41 read as under:

**41. Opening of bids: (4)** All bids shall be opened publicly in the presence of all the bidders, or their representatives who may choose to be present, at the time and place announced in the invitation to bid.

**(5)** The procuring agency shall read aloud the name of the bidder and total amount of each bidder, and of any alternatives bids if they have been permitted, shall be read aloud and recorded when opened.

- ii. The tender documents were issued only to M/s. Naseeb Khan & Brothers which is violation of Rule 44 of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010.


Both the allegations by the complainant are baseless, frivolous, fictitious and against the facts. Regarding allegation No. (i) it is clarified that the work has not been awarded to any one and tenders were opened on 25-05-2011 and CDGK is currently processing / evaluating the bids received. The list of bidders / their representatives in whose presence the bids were opened containing name of bidders and amount of bids announced by the Tender Opening Committee is enclosed.

The other allegation is also unfounded and false. The Tender Documents were issued to 44 (Forty Four) contractors and not only to M/s. Nasseb Khan & Brothers. The list of contractors to whom tender documents were issued is also enclosed.

In view of above facts, which have substantially negated the allegations as there is no violation of Rule 41 and 44 of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 is established. The CDGK is already maintaining the transparency through adoption / compliance of the rules & directives of SPPRA.

It is pertinent to mention that Transparency International, Pakistan has not forwarded the complaint but only communicated the allegations with quoting the name and address of the complaint, therefore, this department is also unable to verify the genuineness of the complaint.

The matter is submitted for kind perusal & advice of the SPPRA being the regulatory authority please.
