Subject: Complaint against EDO (Works & Services) on the corruption in Tendering

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received complaint from Karachi Contractors Association on 21 April 2010 ( copy enclosed) against EDO (Works & Services) on the Award of Contracts, in violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 and SPPRA Public Procurement Rules 2010. Kindly examine the complaint and confirm to TI Pakistan about the allegations of violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 and SPPRA Public Procurement Rules 2010 in these tenders.

Public Procurement Rules, 2004 applicable in Sindh Province since 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2006, and SPPRA Public Procurement Rules 2010 have eliminated all discretions in procurement process and avenues of corrupt practices in tendering, by making the following Transparent Steps mandatory to eliminate manipulation in tenders;

- Signing of Integrity Pact ( no bribery pact and declaration of Agent's Agreement),
- Evaluation Report to be provided to bidders 15 days before award for filing objections.
- Bidders shall be issued tenders on the date of Tender Notice is Published, and allow minimum 15 days for submission of tenders.
- Rights of bidders for complain on evaluation report and reply by department,
- Declaration of Contract and Evaluation Report on the website after the Award on Contract.
- Contract for Supply, Works and Consultants to be awarded only to the lowest responsive Evaluated Bidder.
- No changes allowed in the Specifications or evaluation criteria after opening of Tenders.

These do not allow any discretion, and ensures that no collusive practices occurs among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels which deprives the CDGK of the benefits of free and open competition.
