

SUBJECT: COMPLAINT AGAINST TENDERING PROCEDURES OF CDGK: NIT NO.EDO/ W&S/ CDGK/ S-II/ 177/10 DATED 29TH APRIL, 2010

I am directed to refer to your letter dated 10th July, 2010 on the subject noted above and to communicate Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority's (SPPRA) point of view as follows:

- (i) Sindh Public Procurement (SPP) Rules, 2010 do not stipulate that all procurements of Roads, Bridges, Sewerage, Drainage, Building & Services shall be undertaken only by Single Stage One Envelope bidding procedure. There may be technically complex situations or works requiring innovation, where the procuring agency may have to opt for other procurement methods available in the Rules.
- (ii) It is the prerogative of the procuring agency to select the method of procurement, though it is required to ensure that method adopted is in accordance with the level of complexity/ size/ innovation/ quality required. Moreover, according to Rule-33 of the SPP Rules, 2010 once a particular method has been selected by the procuring agency, it shall not be subject to Appeal/ Review.
