Please refer to this Authority's letter of even number dated 15th August, 2009 and 31st August, 2009 and your office letter No. DG (P&H)/ 1054/ 09 dated 4th September, 2009, on the subject noted above.

2. Vide above referred letters you were requested to provide comments on the queries raised by the Transparency International, Pakistan alongwith details of procurements carried out in the last two years. However, instead of communicating your comments and relevant details, it has been simply informed vide your above reference that your office reply has been communicated to TI, Pakistan.

3. Please be advised that provisions of Section 5 (2) (a) and (f) of Sindh Public Procurement Act 2009, provides that the Authority may;

- (a) examine, evaluate, assess the application of laws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures in respect of or relating to, procurement and also make recommendations thereof;
- (f) call any functionary of procuring agencies to provide assistance in its functions and call for any information from such agencies in pursuance of its objectives and functions;

It is, therefore, once again advised that all relevant details and record of contract agreements, evaluation reports and other relevant details of all procurement above Rs.10 million carried out in the last 24 months may be provided, as already requested by Transparency International, Pakistan as well, without any further delay latest by 15th September, 2009.
