Federal Board of Revenue, Islamabad's Tender Notice to Purchase Giveaways  
(Miscellaneous Items with Printed FBR Logo).

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Federal Board of Revenue, Islamabad's Tender Notice, published in daily "The News" on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per the advertisement, "The Competent Authority has the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason at any time prior to the acceptance of a bids or proposals under Rule No. 33 of PPRA Rules 2004". It is a violation of PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No.33 (1). Stated as under;

*33. Rejection of bids. - (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

## Invitation for Bids (IFB)

FBR management invites sealed bids under National Competitive Bidding (NCB) through Single Stage - One Envelope bidding procedure under Rule 36(a) of the Federal Public Procurement Rules 2004 from the suppliers having vast experience in sale of such items.
2. Details and specifications of items are mentioned in the Standard Bidding Documents which are available at [www.fbr.gov.pk/tenders](http://www.fbr.gov.pk/tenders) and may be obtained by emailing to Secretary (PR) through email at [secretary.pr.fbr@fbr.gov.pk](mailto:secretary.pr.fbr@fbr.gov.pk) free of cost.
3. Bids must be delivered at the office of Secretary (PR), Room No 157, 1st Floor, FBR House, Constitution Avenue, Islamabad at or before **10:00 A.M** on **26th May, 2016 (Thursday)** and shall be opened at **11:00 A.M** on the same date and at the same address, in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives, who choose to attend.
4. The bidders are required to furnish refundable security deposit equal to 5% of bid price in the shape of Pay Order (PO), Demand Draft (DD) or Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) in the name of the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, FBR (HQ), Islamabad in an envelope along with the bid. Late bids will be treated as non-responsive.
5. The bidders should be registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments, having their own office & phone/fax number as a mandatory requirement.
6. The bidders are requested to give their best and final price in local currency, inclusive of all duties & taxes, transportation, labour charges etc, wherever required, along with sample, as per the Specifications mentioned in the Standard Bidding Documents. The bid must be valid up to **30-06-2016**.
7. The Competent Authority has the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposals under Rule 33 of PPRA Rules 2004.
