SUBJECT: COMPLAINT OF COLLUSION BY FBR IN ILLEGAL AWARD OF PERMISSION TO SINGLE PARTY M/S TPL TRAKKER LTD. FOR TRACKING AND MONITORING OF CARGO FACILITATING ONE COMPANY ANNUAL BUSINESS OF RS.4-6 BILLION.

2. The Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) appreciates the efforts of Transparency International for drawing attention to a matter of public interest.
