Subject: RE: Violation of Balochistan Public Procurement Rules 2014, Tender Notice for Procurement of Various Classroom Articles for Primary, Middle, High Schools REF AB 51/2016-17 Dated 11-08-2016.

Reference: Transparency International Pakistan letter no TL16/1508/6A dated 15-08-2016

Kindly refer to your letter no 5038/A&P/6/HS/NAB(B)/2016/314, dated 31-08-2016, regarding violation of Rule 38 of BPPRA 2014, which has been observed by Transparency International vide letter under above stated reference.

2. Under the Project agreement signed between IBRD / IDA (World Bank) and Province of Balochistan, Dated March 25th 2015, under GPE Grant Number TF019124, Procurement Guidelines for procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 (Revised July 2014) shall be followed, against B-PPRA rules.

Furthermore, Rule No. 5 of B-PPRA Rules 2014: Conflict with International and Inter-Governmental Agreements clearly stipulates that in case of agreement with International Financial Institution, the provisions of such agreement shall prevail, in case of inconsistency.

3. In the instant case, the said advertisement clearly stipulates that Procurement will be made under Procurement Guidelines under IBRD and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers (2014). The World Bank Guidelines 2014, section C, Clause 2.61 clearly mentions Rejection of All Bids. It is further elaborated in the bidding document, which clearly stipulates that as per World Bank Guidelines for Procurement of Goods under National Competitive Bidding Part One (FIXED) Section I, Instruction to Bidders, Sub Section F. Award of Contract, Clause 30 Stated as under;

30.1 Purchaser's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or All Bids: The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the Purchaser's actions.

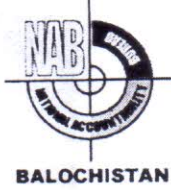
