Subject: Regularization of Branch Primary School Killi Ali Bagh

Dear Sir,

We have received a complaint from Mr. Ali Buksh against the problems he is facing in the regularization of a primary school in Killi Ali Bagh. The detailed complaint is attached along with annexure for your ready reference and is self explanatory.

The complainant alleges that in 1995, the Balochistan Education Department approved the establishment of an unofficial school in Killi Ali Bagh on the direction of the Governor's Secretariat letter no. O(Misc.:)/OB/5-7/86/1051-52 dated 5-4-1995. Since then, the school – which is allegedly the only source of primary education for hundreds in the area – has been running as an “un-official” primary school. In August 2008, upon the complainant's request, the Director of Education(s) Balochistan requested the Executive District Officer of Education in Dera Bugti to prepare a case for the regularization of the school. The complainant alleges that the matter is pending in the Education Department for reasons best known to them, and the school has yet to be regularized.

Transparency International Pakistan would greatly appreciate if you would kindly look into this matter, and if found genuine, pay special attention to the regularization of this school and take appropriate action against the officials who are involved in creating hurdles against its regularization.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving to have **Rule of Law** in Pakistan, which is the only way to eliminate corruption and have good governance in country.
