**Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Director General, Punjab Wildlife & Parks Department, Lahore's Tender Notice for Distribution of Trophies.**

This is with reference to Punjab Wildlife & Parks Department, Lahore's Tender Notice, published in daily "The Nation" on 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2018. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Violation of PPRA 2014.

As per the advertisement, "Director General, Wildlife & Parks Department, Lahore reserves the right to reject all or any of bids without assigning any reason and decision of DG, Wildlife & Parks Department shall be final". However, it is not complying with, PPRA 2014 Rule No. 35, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Therefore the advertisement is in violation of Rule No. 35 of PPRA Rules 2014. Stated as under;

***35. Rejection of Bids :- (1) the procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal.  
(2) the procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any bidder, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but shall not be required to justify those grounds.***

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No. 69, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

## TROPHY HUNTING OF URIAL IN PUNJAB, PAKISTAN

**Hunting Period: 1<sup>st</sup> December to 31<sup>st</sup> March**

The Punjab Wildlife & Parks Department, Lahore, Pakistan, announces Urial trophy hunting permits for 2018-2019.

Distribution of trophies is as under:

Tour operators / Bidders / Outfitters are invited to offer their sealed bids in the name of Director General, Wildlife & Parks, Punjab, Lahore. The bids will be received on **21.11.2018** upto **1.00 pm** and will be opened on the same day in the presence of bidders or their representatives at **2.00 pm**. After completing codal formalities the respective successful bidders will be notified and communicated within **3 days** through Fax or E-mail. Successful Bidders / Outfitters will be required to confirm their acceptance of Trophy Hunting offers by depositing the bid money with the Punjab Wildlife & Parks Department. In case bids are not received on **21.11.2018** then the bids will be received on **26.11.2018** till **1.00 pm** and will be opened at **2.00 pm** on the same day.

Terms & conditions for trophy hunting will be:

1. The offer shall be made in US Dollars. Successful Bidders / Tour operators / Outfitters shall deposit the earnest money i.e. **US\$ 5000** in favour of Director General Wildlife & Parks, Punjab in the official account (Bank of Punjab Account No. CD 0000-53-000-03 DHA Phase-VI, Lahore Branch Code 0329) of the Department in cash and original bank receipt shall be attached with the bid offer. **No bank draft or any other shape of payment shall be acceptable.**
2. The earnest money **US\$ 5000** shall remain deposited in the designated Account of the Department as a security and after completion of successful hunting of urial trophy, the said amount shall be returned to the respective outfitters on their request. In case of any violation of the prescribed terms & conditions by the respective outfitters, the department has right to forfeit the earnest money.
3. Reserve price for one urial trophy will be **US\$ 18000**.
4. Prescribed Gun Shooting Licence fee of **US\$ 500** will be charged in addition to the Trophy hunting Permit Fee. Urial trophy hunting permit shall be issued to the respective hunter subject to payment of approved trophy bid alongwith shooting fee in advance in the designated account of the Department. (Original Bank receipt in this respect shall be required to be attached with the request).
5. Out of the allocated quota of 12 Nos. heads of urial trophy by the Ministry of Climate Change, Islamabad, equal distribution of trophies shall be undertaken for each CBO existing in Salt Range. While the quota of 04 heads of Urial trophy allocated separately shall be reserved for the respective CBO i.e. Kalabagh. In first phase, one trophy each will be distributed amongst the CBOs existing in Salt Range and Kalabagh. Where after completion of one urial trophy by each CBO, the same pattern will be followed for remaining trophies. Distribution of urial trophy for 2018-19 shall start from the CBOs to whom one urial trophy was distributed during 2017-18 and the decision regarding first beneficiary CBO for urial trophy distribution shall be taken through draw. From the next hunting season (2019-20) in the interest of justice / transparency for all rounds, decision shall be taken through draw.
6. Hunting will be permissible only in community managed areas specified in permit.
7. In the case of Tie, bidders will be called for negotiations.
8. The bidders will clearly quote in their bids the number of trophies, applied for by them.
9. One chance will be provided for each trophy and hunter will be required to complete hunt within specified period of consecutive **seven days**.
10. Trophy will be removed from hunting area on the same day of hunt.
11. No hunting other than Trophy of Urial will be allowed in the hunting area. In case of injuries or death of other animal caused by the hunter, **penalty of US\$ equivalent to the approved bid amount will be recovered from the hunter/outfitter.**
12. The outfitters/hunters will be required to apply for separate licence for possession of trophy or export permit whatever the case may be:- Possession fee will be charged @ **US \$ 100**, whereas Export fee will be **US \$ 200**.
13. CITES export permit will be issued by the Ministry of Climate Change, Government of Pakistan for hunted trophies on recommendation of Punjab Wildlife & Parks Department.
14. The hunters will be strictly bound to observe hunting period. No relaxation in hunting period will be allowed in any case.
15. Security of the foreign hunters will be the exclusive responsibility of the outfitters/respective CBO.
16. The Director General, Wildlife & Parks, Punjab reserves the right to reject all or any of bids without assigning any reasons and the decision of Director General, Wildlife & Parks Punjab shall be final.
