<u>Efficiency & Conservation Agency (PEECA), Lahore's Expression of Interest (EOI) Notice</u>
for Provision of Testing Services.

Dear Sir.

This is with reference to PEECA, Lahore's EOI Notice published in daily "The News" on 9th December, 2016. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the Punjab Procurement Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, no expression of interest document is issued for bidders, whereas as per Rule No. (47), it is mandatory to provide a set of EOI document that should include evaluation criteria for the applicants. Stated as under;

- **47.** Expression of interest.- (1) A request for expression of interest shall be advertised in accordance with the provisions of rule 12 and rule 13.
- (2) The expression of interest shall contain the following information:
- (a) the name and address of procuring agency;
- (b) an appropriate description of the assignment providing scope of the intellectual and professional services required;
- (c) closing date and place of the submission of the expression of interest;
- (d) criteria for short listing or prequalification where required; and
- (e) any other information that the procuring agency may deem appropriate to disseminate at this stage.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the EOI notice under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
