Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Director, National Commission for Human Rights, Islamabad's Tender Notices for Supply of Equipment, Machinery & Other Items

Dear Madam,

This is with reference to NCHR, Islamabad's Tender Notice published in daily "Dawn" on 5th July, 2016. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per advertisement, "The quantity mentioned in the bidding documents are approximate and may be increased or decreased by NCHR", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No. 42 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under:

42. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works, namely:-

(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:

(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

The quantities mentioned in the bidding documents are approximate and may be decreased or increased by NCHR.

The interested parties may submit their sealed bids duly inscribed "**Bid for Machinery/equipment**", quoting rates of per unit item and GST thereon separately, through registered post/ courier service, which should reach the undersigned by 1100 hours on 26 July 2016 at 5th Floor, Evacuee Trust Complex, Islamabad. The bids will be opened at 1130 hours the same day in presence of authorized representatives of the bidders who choose to attend the bid opening.
3. No bid will be entertained which does not fulfil the conditions laid down in the Terms and Conditions.
