**Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, General Manager (Procurement & Contract),  
Lahore Waste Management Company, Lahore's Expression of Interest Notice for Services for  
Operation & Maintenance of Sanitary Landfill Site.**

Dear Sir

This is with reference to LWMC, Lahore's EOI Notice, published in daily "The News" on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab PRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, no EOI document is issued for bidders, whereas as per Rule No. (47), it is mandatory to provide a set of EOI document that should include evaluation criteria for the applicants. Stated as under;

*47. Expression of interest.- (1) A request for expression of interest shall be advertised in accordance with the provisions of rule 12 and rule 13.*

*(2) The expression of interest shall contain the following information:*

*(a) the name and address of procuring agency;*

*(b) an appropriate description of the assignment providing scope of the intellectual and professional services required;*

*(c) closing date and place of the submission of the expression of interest;*


*(d) criteria for short listing or prequalification where required; and*

*(e) any other information that the procuring agency may deem appropriate to disseminate at this stage.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the pre-qualification Notice under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

**HIRING THE SERVICES OF CONSULTING FIRM FOR THIRD PARTY SERVICES  
(RESIDENT SUPERVISION) FOR OPERATION & MAINTENANCE OF SANITARY  
LANDFILL SITE AT LAKHODAIR, LAHORE**

1. M/s. Lahore Waste Management Company (LWMC) has been entrusted by the City District Government Lahore (CDGL) to perform Solid Waste Management functions in Lahore. The entrusted functions also include operation and maintenance of a Sanitary Landfill Site at Lakhodair, Lahore. LWMC has already initiated the procurement process under international competitive bidding to select a foreign operator to operate and maintain the landfill site.
2. LWMC intends to hire services of consulting firm for third party services (resident supervision) for the project "Operation & Maintenance of Sanitary Landfill Site at Lakhoder, Lahore" costing more than Rs. 3000 million over the period of five years. The consultant shall provide assistance to the client to implement all programs, standards and procedures required to operate and maintain the landfill site by the foreign Operator.
3. Expression of Interest (EOI) is invited from the engineering consulting firms with following information / documents:
  - i) Registration with Income Tax Department
  - ii) Taxpayer Status of last Five (05) Years
  - iii) Registration with PRA/ Sales Tax.
  - iv) Registration with Registrar of Firm
  - v) Registration with Securities & Exchange Commission of Pakistan along with latest certified copy of Form 29 and A.
  - vi) List of similar assignments (minimum Three (03)) completed by the firm during last ten (10) years and similar assignments in hand, indicating total cost of such assignment and cost of consultancy fee received against those assignments along with performance certificate issued by the Client and copy of contract agreement of such assignments.
  - vii) Income Tax returns for duration corresponding with tax payer Status
  - viii) Audited statements of accounts for the last three (3) years.
  - ix) Bank Statement showing financial soundness
  - x) Certificate of registration with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) along with the latest renewal letter.
  - xi) A certificate / affidavit that the firm is not blacklisted by any Govt./Autonomous Body.
  - xii) Copy List of permanent professional staff along with C.Vs of relevant core staff showing project wise experience with exact time duration for each project along with
  - xiii) Copy of CNIC and affidavit of the staff on judicial paper that they are permanent employee of the firm.
4. Domestic engineering consulting firms with the requisite profile may submit their EOI on or before the deadline **March 29, 2016** on the address given below.
5. Failure to provide above mentioned documents or missing of anyone document may lead to disqualification of the application.
6. Applicants will be informed, in due course, of the result of the evaluation of applications. Only the firms and joint ventures shortlisted under this process will be invited for the participation in bidding.
