Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Director General, Fort Munro Development Authority, Dera Ghazi Khan's Expression of Interest Notice for Consultancy Services.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to FMDA, Dera Ghazi Khan's EOI Notice, published in daily "Nawaiwaqt" on 15th July, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "The consultant selection Committee (CSC) reserves the right to reject all applications without assigning any reason". However, as per Rule No. 17 (4), PPRA 2014, the reason of rejection should be communicated to the bidders. Stated as under;

17. Pre-qualification process:- (4) On a request, the procuring agency shall communicate to the contractor who has not been prequalified the reasons for not prequalifying the contractor.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No. 69, and with request to re-invite the EOI under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Expression of Interest (EOI)

For this purpose, the commissioner, D.G Khan Fort Munro as an employer intends to hire consultancy services from competent and well reputed consulting firms to ensure good quality works and expeditious completion of the development schemes in Roads, Building, Water Supply & Sanitation and Municipal Services sectors on the following terms and conditions:-

- i. The consultant shall be responsible for the top supervision of the schemes by a qualified graduate engineer in the respective discipline with minimum 10 years of experience in the relevant field.
 - ii. The consultant shall certify that the works are executed as per design, drawing and standard specification/ technically sanctioned as per agreement:
 - iii. The consultant shall certify the works are executed in accordance with the established standard criteria and procedure.
 - iv. The consultant shall certify that the material brought by the contractor at site for use in the works are in accordance with the specification and is tested as per standard practice laid down in specification
 - v. The consultant shall advise the executing department in any problem arising during the execution of work and suggest remedial measures:
 - vi. The consultant shall submit progress/ inspection report to the Fort Munro Development Authority at the end of each month
 - vii. The consultant shall verify contractor's monthly running payments as per contract agreement and certify final payment:
 - viii. The consultant shall verify the completion certificate duly submitted by the contractor.
 - ix. One month prior to the expiry of maintenance period of the work, the consultant shall carry out a detailed final inspection of the work and submit comprehensive report to the execution department by pointing out the defects (if any).
 - x. During the service life of the work, the quantity of any item of work executed at site and found defective / substandard, the consultant besides contractor shall also be liable to pay the compensation to the client department of the defective work.
 - xi. The department will be at liberty to increase or decrease quantum of work without assigning any reasons:
 - xii. The consultant's fee will be linked to the contractor's payment / physical progress of the work
 - xiii. The client department will deduct 10% of each payment due to the consultant as security which would be paid on the completion of the assignment / submission of final report
 - xiv. Final payment to the consultant shall be made only when the consulting services have been completed satisfactory by the firm and duly certified by the competent authority:
