Subject: **VIOLATION OF PUNJAB PROCUREMENT RULES 2014, TENDER NOTICE FOR PURCHASE OF FOOD ITEMS FOR HORSES.**

Memorandum:


Please refer to your office letter No. TL17/2605/8A, dated 26.05.2017.

2. It is intimated that Capital City Police Office, Lahore delegated the various DDO Powers to the undersigned regarding affairs of Operations Wing, Lahore. Earlier all kinds of Tender notices were issued by the Capital City Police Officer, Lahore being Head of the District Lahore. Undersigned issued this tender notice on the same conditions and no objection was received from any corner.

3. This office has not committed any violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014 as said rules 59 (c) (iv) provide authority for direct contraction and repeat orders not exceeding 15 percent of the original Procurement.

4. In response to the objection raised in your letter "that the purchase of tender items can be increased or decreased" is not allowed under the rules. In this regard it is stated that Food items mentioned in the Tender Notice is comprising of daily requirement of Food of Winter/Summer Seasons of each Horse. If any horse of Police Department dies of Police Department purchased new horses then under the such bid revised order would be issued which will not be exceeded 15 percent of original Procurement.

5. In view of above circumstances, Tender Notice issued in daily Newspapers "The Nation" 26.05.2017 and "Jang" 27.05.2017 is according the rules and not need any corrigendum. It is added that this office is thankful to you for giving such advised, please.
