**Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Section Officer (General),  
Home Department, Government of Punjab, Lahore's Tender Notice for  
Purchase of Computer Hardware, Machinery, Equipment.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Home Department, Government of Punjab, Lahore's Tender Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab PPRA 2014.


As per the advertisement, "the competent authority reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity/ No. of any one or all tenders' items", whereas per rules, any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after the opening of the bid by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRA 2014, Rule No. 59 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

*59. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works:  
(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:  
(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No. 69, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

4. All rates shall be Sales Tax & Income Tax inclusive.
5. The delivery of items shall have to be made at Home Department, Civil Secretariat.
6. Department shall be authorized to deduct Income Tax as per prevalent rate.
7. Successful bidder shall deposit three percent of the total value of purchase order as security/guarantee through pay order or draft in favor of Senior Purchase Officer, Home Department within two days in case of the approval of tender or else tender shall be rejected.

Interested companies can submit their sealed tenders complete in every respect by 15 days of the publication of this advertisement till 11:00am, which shall be opened the same day before purchase committee members, quotationers or their representatives at 12:00 noon. The competent authority, under PPRA Rules 35, 2014 reserves the right to reject or cancel tender without assigning any reason thereof, which could not be challenged in any court of law, and also reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity / No. of any one or all tenders' items. The CDR of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned at the spot upon written request. Further details can be had from the General Wing, Home Department during working hours.
