**Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Pakistan LNG Limited, Islamabad's
Tender Notice for Supply of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG).**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Pakistan LNG Limited, Islamabad's Tender Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 16th May, 2018. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

As per advertisement, "Pakistan LNG Limited reserves the right at its sole discretion to accept or reject any or all bids and without any liability whatsoever". It is not complying with PPRA Rules 2004, No. 33, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Stated as under;

33. Rejection of bids. - (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
