**Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Executive Engineer- II,
Cholistan Development Authority, Bahawalpur's Tender Notice for Providing &
Fixing of 07 NOs Generators in Cholistan.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to CDA, Bahawalpur's Tender Notice, published in daily "Express" on 23rd March, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab PRA 2014.


As per advertisement CDA, Bahawalpur's has restricted the bidders to supply generator of U.S, European or UK made only and has not added "**or equivalent**" with it, which is not allowed under PPRA 2014, Rule No. 10(2). Stated as under:

10. Specifications:- (2) The Specifications shall be generic and shall not include references to brand names, model numbers, catalogue numbers or similar classifications but if the procuring agency is satisfied that the use of, or a reference to, a brand name or a catalogue number is essential to complete an otherwise incomplete specification, such use or reference shall be qualified with the words "or equivalent".

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

1. Cholistan Development Authority, Bahawalpur invites sealed bids from the well reputed manufactures / firms / suppliers, registered with Sales Tax and Income Tax Departments, for providing and fixing of 07 Nos. Generators in Cholistan District Rahimyar Khan as per detail given below.
2. The Bidding documents containing detailed specification and terms and condition will be available upto 08-04-2017 during working hours from the office of Divisional Accountant, Cholistan Development Authority, Bahawalpur on payment of Rs. 2000/- in shape of pay order (non refundable) in favour of Managing Director, Cholistan Development Authority, Bahawalpur.
3. The procurement shall be completed in accordance with Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, on single Stage- Two Envelopes bidding procedure.
4. A single package containing two envelopes, Technical and financial separate bids, duly completed signed, stamped sealed and in complete conformity with Bidding Documents should reach in the office of the Director (Admn), Cholistan Development Authority, Bahawalpur not later than 12:00 (noon) on 10-04-2017 Technical Bids will be opened first on the same day at 12:30 PM. Financial Bids will be opened of only technically qualified bidders as per schedule issued later on. Whereas, Financial Bids of technically disqualified / unsuccessful bidders will be returned un-opened. Bids will be opened in the presence of firms or their representatives who wish to attend.
5. Bids must be accompanied by Bid Security at the rate of 5% of total bid value in shape of CDR in favour of Managing Director, Cholistan Development Authority, Bahawalpur. The CDRs / Bid security (in original) must be attached with Financial Bids. Bids unsealed, without bid security, late submitted will not be considered.
6. Income /sales tax Registration Certificate CNIC and other documents as mentioned in the Bidding Documents must accompany the bids. Taxes will be deducted as per GOP rules.
7. The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals as per PPRA Rule-35 (rejection of bids)
8. The competent authority, shall upon request communicate to any bidder, the grounds for its rejection of all bids but shall not be required to justify these grounds.
9. Other term & condition can be seen in the office of the undersigned during office hours on any working day.
