Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, District Livestock Officer, Attock's Tender Notice for Purchase of Veterinary Medicine.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to District Livestock Officer, Attock's Tender Notice published in daily "The News" on 24th November, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab Procurement Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "Quantity may vary in accordance with competitive bidding rates or budget position", whereas per rules, any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after the opening of the bid by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRRA 2014, Rule No. 59 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

59. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works:


(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:

(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement:

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the notice under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Livestock Department District Government Attock intends to purchase of Veterinary Medicine under PPRA rules 2014) for its Veterinary Institutions. Tender are invited from well reputed registered firms.

1. Detail of medicines can be received from District Livestock Office Attock during office hours.
2. Offer can be given by the registered Manufacturing Firms which have been registered by the Ministry of Health Govt. of Pakistan.

TERMS & CONDITION

1. Pre-qualified firms /dealers will attach documents along with tenders.
 - i. License of manufacturing for manufactures.
 - ii. Certificate of prequalification.
 - iii. Certificate of drug registration with Ministry of Health Government of Pakistan.
 - iv. Original price list of medicines.
 - v. National Income tax number/certificate.
 - vi. GST certificate if concerned.
2. An affidavit attested from notary public will be provided by the supplier at time of supply of consignment having statement that:-
 - i. Medicines have been supplied on hospital rates and their prices are not higher than market rates.
 - ii. Medicines are fresh and of good quality & have more than two year expiry.
 - iii. The supplier will be responsible for its standard quality and will also be responsible for any kind of damage.
 - iv. The rate contract will be valid up to 30.06.2017.
3. All the medicine should be supplied within one month of issuance of supply order. Otherwise the supply order will be considered canceled & call deposit will be confiscated.
4. A call deposit for English /Desi medicines must be attached which is 2% of the total budget fixed for medicines with the tender at the name of DLO Attock.
5. All types of expenditures including income tax, breakage & transportation to the store of District Livestock Office will be responsibility of suppliers.
6. All the supplied medicines must be bearing stamp of "District Government Attock Property not for sale" on its label.
7. All the drug suppliers are bound to provide drug warranty according to drug Act-1972.
8. Last date of receiving quotations/tender will be 12.12.2016 on Monday at 12:00 pm in the office of District Livestock Officer Attock and the tender will be opened on same day at 2:00 pm. In the presence of the District tender board, authorized dealers or their representatives.
9. The District Tender board reserves the right to reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal.
10. Quantity may vary in accordance with competitive bidding rates or budget position.
11. The bidders will be bound to provide sample of their medicines to the District Livestock Office Attock.
