Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Pakistan Rangers (Punjab), Lahore's Tender Notices published in daily "The Nation" on 23rd August, 2016. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

As per the advertisement, "Director General, Pakistan Rangers (Punjab) have the right to increase/ decrease in quantity of items". Any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRA Rules 2004, No. 42 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

- **42.** Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works, namely:-
- (c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:
- (iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tenders under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
