Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Training School, Multan's Tender Notice for Repair of Building Works.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Police Training School, Multan's Tender Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 25th April, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "the SSP/ PTI, Multan reserves the right to increase/ decrease the Repair of Building works", whereas per rules, any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after the opening of the bid by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRA 2014, Rule No. 59 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

59. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works:


(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:

(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No. 69, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Sealed tenders (separate for each category) are invited from the authorized Govt. Building Contractors (repair of building) having Registration of Sale Tax and National Tax Number (Repair of buildings work), of Police Training Institute, Multan which may reach in this office on 12th May, 2016 till 09:00 A.M. The Tenders/ Bids shall be opened on the same day at 9:30 A.M.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Bidding/ Procurement will be made under the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
- 2 The tender/ bid must be supported by 2% refundable bid security of the estimated price in the form of draft in the name of SSP/ PTI, Multan.
- 3 Bidders shall obtain bidding documents immediately after proclamation on PPRA website and news paper containing specifications and terms & conditions etc. from the office of the undersigned within office hours i.e. 08:00 A.M. to 03:00 P.M. after payment of non-refundable fee of Rs. 500/-.
- 4 The bidding procedure will be governed by Rule 38(2) (a) i.e. "Single Stage Two Envelopes Bidding". Each bidder will submit a "Technical bid" and a "Financial bid" in separate sealed envelopes, one sealed envelope for technical bid and second sealed envelope for financial bid. Both these envelopes will then be kept in the third sealed envelope which must be received in the office of the undersigned latest by 12th May, 2016 till 09:00 A.M. through postal/ courier service only. No tender/ bid will be accepted by hand.
- 5 The third envelope containing technical and financial bid envelopes of available bidders will be opened on 12th May at 09:30 A.M. in the office of the undersigned, in the presence committee repair of building works committees and available bidders.
- 6 In the first instance, the "Technical Proposal" shall be opened and the envelope marked as "Financial Proposal" shall be retained unopened in the custody of the procuring agency.
- 7 The procuring agency shall evaluate the technical proposal in the manner prescribed in advance, without reference to the price and shall reject any proposal which does not conform to the specified requirements. During the technical evaluation no amendments in the technical proposal shall be permitted. The financial bids found technically non-responsive shall be returned un-opened to the respective bidders.
- 8 After the evolution and approval of the technical proposals, the procuring agency shall open the financial proposal of the technically accepted bids, on the same date and place. The lowest evaluated bidder shall be awarded the contract.
- 9 Incomplete/ late received tenders will not be entertained.
- 10 A procurement contract, within the meaning of Rule: 55 of the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 will have to be signed by the successful bidder. The successful bidder shall complete repair work within 20 days repeat within 20 days positively without fail.
- 11 The procuring agency i.e. SSP/ PTI, Multan reserves the right to increase/ decrease the Repair of Building works. The said authority also reserves the right to reject all/ partially the bids according to Rule; 35 of the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
