**SUBJECT: VIOLATION OF PUNJAB PROCUREMENT RULES 2014,  
DIRECTOR GENERAL, THE PUNJAB WILDLIFE & PARKS  
DEPARTMENT, LAHORE'S TENDER NOTICE FOR TROPHY  
HUNTING OF URIAL IN PUNJAB**

Reference: Your letter No.TL17/3011 dated 30.11.2017 and subsequent letter  
No.TL17/1412/18A dated 14.12.2017.

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that every year Ministry of Climate Change, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad allocates the quota of Urial trophies for the Punjab Province. After the allocation of quota for the season 2017-18, the Punjab Wildlife & Parks Department floated an advertisement in the press for invitation of the bids for sale/auction of Urial trophies and a period of one week was fixed for the submission / opening of bids. It was sale/auction notice and not the tender notice pertaining to any procurement as mentioned in the subject PPRA Rules.

In your earlier letter dated 30.11.2017 it was objected that the period of 07-days was too short for the submission / opening of bids, therefore, 15-days of response time may be given as provided under the PPRA Rules. In this regard it is stated that the sale / auction is not covered under the PPRA Rules and the same was communicated to you vide this office letter No.3792/DG.W&P/MGT/2017 dated 07.12.2017. However, this Department re-advertised the sale/auction of Urial trophies giving the response time of 15 days.

As regards the objection raised in your letter dated 14.12.2017 regarding TOR 16 of the advertisement, it is stated that PPRA Rules do not apply to the sale/auction of Urial trophies and the rules ibid apply in the case of

procurement. Hence, your objection is not maintainable under the clarification made.
