

CHISHTIAN TENDER NOTICE FOR MISCELLANEOUS
WORKS.**

Kindly refer to your office letter No.TL17/1412/12A dated 14th December 2017 on the subject cited above.

In this connection it is submitted that while publishing of advertisement in the newspapers or PPRA website, municipal committee Chishtian has not violated any rule of PPRA. The objection raised by Transparency international Pakistan is a result of misreading of advertisement. As per Rule, 35 the MC Chishtian has clearly mentioned in the Term # 5, 7 of the advertisement that procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of bid or proposal. Hence there is no violation of Rule 35(1). Rule 35(2) is subject to the rejection of bids or proposals. It is pertinent to mention here that if procuring agency reject any or all bids or proposals after its receiving, then grounds will also be communicate to any bidder upon his request.

So, Municipal Committee Chishtian has not committed any violation of PPRA Rules, 2014. Hence, the instant objection raised by Transparency International Pakistan may be rejected please.
