**Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, District Coordination Officer, Layyah's
Pre-Qualification Notice for Provision of Food Items for Flood Affecters.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to District Coordination Office, Layyah's Pre-Qualification Notice, published in daily "The News" on 26th July, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab PRA 2014.

As per advertisement, "Special Purchase Committee/ Authority has right to accept or reject one or all offers without assigning any reason before or after issuance of work order". However, as per Rule No. 17(4), PPRA 2014, the reason of rejection should be communicated to the bidders. Stated as under;

17. Pre-qualification process:- (4) On a request, the procuring agency shall communicate to the contractor who has not been prequalified the reasons for not prequalifying the contractor.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the pre-qualification under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

All branded items shall be provided in original manufacturer's packing. All packed items shall be packed in a large poly bags. Poly bag containing all items shall be packed in a printed 80 Grams polypropylene bag duly sealed with stitch machine.

1.	Technical proposals can be submitted by hand or reached through dak till 1-30 PM 10 th August 2016, whereas the same will be opened on 02-00 PM in the office of DCO Layyah. Only technically qualified firms will be invited for submission of financial offers till 12 th August 2016 at 1.30 PM that will be opened on 02-00 PM 2016 (same day).
2.	A call deposit of Rs. 50000- in favor of District Coordination Officer, Layyah shall be attached.
3.	Item No. 1 to 14 shall be provided in poly bags.
4.	All permissible Govt. Taxes will be applicable.
5.	Incomplete, mutilated received after due date offers will not be considered.
6.	Special purchase committee/authority has right to accept or reject one or all offers without assigning any reason before or after issuance of work order.
7.	Decision of the special purchase committee/authority will be final & unchallengeable in any court of law.
8.	Tentative list of relief camps may be obtained from the office of DCO. Layyah.
