**Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Executive Engineer, Public Health
Engineer Division, Sheikhupura's Pre-Qualification Notice for Rehabilitating Dysfunctional
Rural Water Supply Scheme.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to PHE, Sheikhupura's Tender Notice published in daily "The Nation" on 29th March, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA 2014.


As per advertisement, the pre-qualification documents can be purchased till 07-04-2017, which means tender documents are not available for the bidders for 15 days. The rule "Response Time" includes purchase of tender/ pre-qualification documents for the bidder from the date of publishing of advertisement till the date of submission of bids/ proposals. Therefore, this is a violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Rule No.14 (1).

14. Response time:- (1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the complexity of the procurement, availability and urgency but, in no circumstances, the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the pre-qualification under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Pre-qualification of contractors / firms having experience and technical expertise for execution of work of similar nature is required by the Chief Engineer (North) Punjab, Public Health Engineering Department, Lahore under the PPA Rule Chapter IV (Prequalification 16-1) amended upto 06.01.2016. Sealed applications are invited for the pre-qualification of contractors / firms who had been enlisted / renewed with HUD & PHE Department for the year 2016-17 and with the Pakistan Engineering Council for the year 2017 having excellent reputation in the construction of Water Supply projects.

The willing contractors / Firms of above mentioned category are required to submit the application along with the following information / documents for pre-qualification for the year 2016-2017 upto **17-04-2017** in the office of the Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division Civil lines Sheikhupura.

- Name of firms/ contractors, partnership deed/articles of association in case of company/ limited firm, complete address and telephone No. of persons with power of attorney in favour of persons authorized by the firms/ contractors.
- Attested copies of enlistment/ renewal for the year 2016-17 with HUD & PHED; valid registration of Pakistan Engineering Council for the year 2017 having relevant categories with specialization Category CE 09, CE 10 (Water Supply & Sewerage / Drainage Project) for the Calendar year 2017.
 - Year of establishment of firm/ company with proof.
 - List of Similar nature of completed works, (as per P&D Department criteria) cost of each work (equal or greater), scope of work with verification from concerned Executive Engineer (without verification no work will be entertained).
 - Name of similar projects already completed during last five years with the completion certificates from the concerned office and number of projects presently in hand along with their magnitude and period and report about quality & pace of work from the concerned Department.
- Proof of financial standing duly supported with documentary proof/ bank certificate. (Balance sheet issued by the concerned bank officer be provided which clearly shows financial position). That the contractor / firm is sound enough to execute the project keeping in view the works already in hand and involvement of financial implication in those projects.
- Proof of registration with the Income Tax Department along with a certificate of payment of taxes for the last three years to date (which can be inspected on one day notice by the consultant).
- Particulars of specified construction equipments / machinery available with the firms/ contractors with verified ownership documents. Especially mention equipment the application intends to deploy for the works. Application should also include the yearly increased in T&P in the last five years. Also mention where this machinery / equipment can be inspected.
- Permanent business management, financial management and technical staff.
 - List of Graduate Engineers, Sub Engineers, Surveyors, and Draftsman on the roll of firm (with proof of salary transaction through bank) along with their experience and standing with the company/ firm and appointment letter, proof of payment of salary of technical/non technical clerical staff.
 - Engineers, Technical Employees of the firm / company will have to present before the prequalification committee on given date & time with proof that they are employee of the firm.
- The application must establish its financial soundness and a certificate from Chartered Accounts firm. Copy of upto date balance sheet should also be part of the application.
- Details of any Arbitration / Litigation or similar proceedings against any Government or Semi Government Department, showing extent and result.
- Undertaking on judicial paper that the firm was never black listed by any of the Government or Semi Government organization.
- Any firm responsible / involved in lapse of funds during last 3 years due to slow progress will not be considered for pre-qualification.
- Each page should be signed, numbered with firm stamp. No page with stamp and number will be accepted.

RULES AND REGULATION.

- Any concealment about the information / detail mentioned above will result in disqualification of the firm.
- In case of Incomplete information, prequalification application will be rejected and will not be considered for pre-qualification.
- Applicant, firms / contractors are required to give undertaking that they have carefully studied the prequalification notice and will abide by the rules and regulations.


