Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Training Institute, Multan's Tender Notice for Supply of Miscellaneous Dietary Items.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Police Training Institute, Multan's Tender Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 28th May, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab PRA 2014.

As per the advertisement, Police Training Institute, Multan's reserves all the rights to accept or reject any or all tenders without giving any reason. However, it is not complying with, PPRA 2014, Rule No. 35, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Therefore the advertisement is in violation of Rule No. 35 of PPRA Rules 2014. Stated as under;

*35. Rejection of Bids :- (1) the procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal.
(2) the procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any bidder, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but shall not be required to justify those grounds.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Bidding / Procurement will be made under the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.
- The tender bid must be supported by 2% refundable bid security of the estimated price in the form of bank draft in the name of SSP / PTI, Multan.
- Bidders shall obtain bidding documents immediately after proclamation on PPTSA website and read paper containing specifications and terms & conditions etc from the office of the undersigned during office hours i.e. 09:00 A.M. to 05:00 P.M. after payment of non-refundable fee of Rs. 500/-.
- The bidding procedure will be governed by Rule 30(2)(a) i.e. "Single Stage Two Envelopes Bidding". Each bidder will submit a "Technical Bid" and a "Financial Bid" in separate sealed envelopes, one sealed envelope for technical bid and second sealed envelope for financial bid. Both these envelopes will then be kept in the first sealed envelope which shall be received in the office of the undersigned latest by 24th June 2017 at 09:00 A.M.
- The first envelope containing technical and financial bid envelopes of suitable bidders will be opened on the same day at 09:30 A.M. in the office of the undersigned, in the presence of committee / firms representatives.
- In the first instance, the "Technical Proposal" shall be opened and the envelope marked as "Financial Proposal" shall be returned unopened in the custody of the procuring agency.
- The procuring agency shall evaluate the technical proposal in the manner prescribed in advance without reference to the price and shall reject any proposal which does not conform to the specified requirements. During the technical evaluation no amendments in the technical proposal shall be permitted. The financial bids found technically non-responsive shall be returned unopened to the respective bidders. After the evaluation and approval of the technical proposals, the procuring agency shall open the financial proposal of the technically accepted bids on the same date and place. The lowest evaluated bidder shall be awarded the contract.
- After the evaluation and approval of the technical proposals the procuring agency shall open the financial proposals of the technically accepted bids on the same date and place and the lowest evaluated bidder shall be awarded the contract.
- A procurement contract within the meaning of rule 52 of the Punjab Procurement Rule 2014 will have to be signed by the successful bidder. The successful bidder shall complete the contract.
- An affidavit should be provided by the bidder that the firm has never been blacklisted by any Govt. Department.
- The bidder shall deposit his samples of items/articles at the time of opening of tenders/bids otherwise, the offers shall be ignored.
- The amendments of all participants will be got verified through the special branch and the local police keeping in view of the prevailing law and order situation.
- The bidders are accepted to examine the bidding documents / tender notice, including all instructions, terms and conditions, specification etc. Failure to furnish all information / documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding documents / tender notice in all respect would be resulted in the rejection of the bid.
- The successful bidder is responsible to supply fresh / clean/dietary items on daily basis at the name of Police Training Institute, Multan according to the supply order. Expired date dietary items shall not be accepted.
- The undersigned reserves all the rights to accept or reject any or all tenders without giving any reason.
