As per the advertisement, "The Engineer-in-charge reserves the right to drop/ reduce / increase any work to any extent at any time without assigning any reason", whereas per rules, any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after the opening of the bid by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRA 2014, Rule No. 59 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

59. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works:
(c) **direct contracting:** a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:
(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;



Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint from M/s Outstart Tech against Excise, Taxation and Narcotics Control Punjab on tender process in "Procurement of Networking".

The complainant has alleged that;

1. A clause is mentioned in the bidding document in technical specification on Page no. 5, "The participants will have to submit samples of each item along with the proposal non-returnable. Failure to which firm will be disqualified".
2. This clause is restrictive as the sample costs Rs. 1 Lakh and is non-returnable if the firm is disqualified.
3. Several firms have been disqualified because they did not submit the samples with the bid documents.

TIP's observation is that it is a difficult and discriminatory clause and will restrict competition. It is a violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Rule No. 32. Stated as under;

32. Discriminatory and difficult conditions - Save as otherwise provided, no procuring agency shall introduce any condition, which discriminates between bidders or that is considered to be met with difficulty. In ascertaining the discriminatory or difficult nature of any condition reference shall be made to the ordinary practices of that trade, manufacturing, construction business or service to which that particular procurement is related.

Secretary, Excise, Taxation and Narcotics Control Department is requested to kindly examine the complaint and if the allegation is found correct direct the concerned department to modify the bidding document clause so healthy competition may take place.

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint against Oil and Gas Regularity Authority (OGRA) for procurement of fuel marking award contract to minimize oil adulteration to Oil Companies Advisory Committee (OCAC).

The complaint has alleged that;

1. The tender notice was not floated in any national newspaper.
2. The whole process was managed by OCAC.
3. OCAC identified 6 companies who were given the prequalification and EOI.
4. Third party consultant was hired to develop ITB (Instructions to Bidders).
5. Only 2 companies responded to the ITB.
6. Final bid was only submitted by one firm.
7. The contract of fuel marking award has been awarded without tender process.

Please also refers to the news article published on 5th October, 2017 in daily 'The Express Tribune' (Annexure A) and 22nd June, 17 in daily 'Dawn' (Annexure B), related to the above said tender. (Copies are enclosed for your ready reference). In the news article the following is stated:

The Hydrocarbon Development Institute of Pakistan (HDIP) has stated the news article published on 22nd June, 2017;

"it was not consulted or taken on board , at any stage of the bidding process, against the stipulation in the minutes and its first involvement began with the opening of single technical bid on June 2, 2017"

TIP's observation is that, there has been violation of PPRA Rules 2004. Rule 12 (2) for not advertising the tender notice and Rule No. 23 (1) for not providing of bidding documents;

Rule 12 Methods of advertisement.- (2) All procurement opportunities over two million rupees should be advertised on the Authority's website as well as in other print media or newspapers having wide circulation. The advertisement in the newspapers shall principally appear in at least two national dailies, one in English and the other in Urdu.

Rule 23 Bidding Documents: - (1) Procuring agencies shall formulate precise and unambiguous bidding documents that shall be made available to the bidders immediately after the publication of the invitation to bid.



(2) For competitive bidding, whether open or limited, the bidding documents shall include the following, namely:-

- (a) invitation to bid;
- (b) instructions to bidders;
- (c) form of bid;
- (d) form of contract;
- (e) general or special conditions of contract;
- (f) specifications and drawings or performance criteria (where applicable);
- (g) list of goods or bill of quantities (where applicable);
- (h) delivery time or completion schedule;
- (i) qualification criteria (where applicable);
- (j) bid evaluation criteria;
- (k) format of all securities required (where applicable);
- (l) details of standards (if any) that are to be used in assessing the quality of goods, works or services specified; and
- (m) any other detail not inconsistent with these rules that the procuring agency may deem necessary.

NAB has also directed vide its letter No 5-2 (75) Pre/ A & P/ NABHQ/ 2013 dated 8th January (Copy encl), that all procuring agencies should make available the bidding or prequalification documents and other related communication in downloaded format, for any interested bidder or party, at their website to use these documents for submitting bid(s) with admissible tender fee, if any, paid in bank as prescribed by procuring agency. NAB has also declared mis-procurement as liable for cognizance by NAB under relevant section of NAO 1999.

Govt picks UK firm for fuel marking to check adulteration

ISLAMABAD: The government has decided to launch a fuel marking programme in an effort to curb the mixing of cheap kerosene oil with high-speed diesel, said a senior government official.

At present, Pakistan refineries are producing kerosene oil without adding any dye, which makes it difficult to detect its mixing with high-speed diesel. Under the fuel marking programme, a chemical will be added to kerosene oil to help identify and check adulteration.

“The price difference between kerosene oil and high-speed diesel is Rs33.40 per litre, that’s why oil barons are minting money by mixing kerosene oil with high-speed diesel,” the government official told The Express Tribune.

UK assures Pakistan of support in GSP Plus status review

He revealed that a technical committee, headed by the Oil Companies Advisory Council (OCAC) and comprising representatives of the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra), refineries and the Hydrocarbon Development Institute of Pakistan (HDIP), had been constituted to implement the fuel marking programme.

The committee has completed the bidding process and Authentix of the UK has been declared successful bidder. The cost of fuel marking has been quoted up to Rs1.22 per litre of oil for six months on a trial basis.

The fuel marking programme will be run in phases. Initially, kerosene oil will be targeted and later other fuels such as high-speed diesel, light diesel oil and petrol will be covered under the programme.

The official pointed out that annual production of superior kerosene oil at domestic refineries stood at around 140,000 to 150,000 tons for consumption inside the country.

The mixing of petroleum products has not only caused shortage of kerosene oil in the domestic market, but it has also hit government revenues on high-speed diesel sales.

He said specifications of kerosene oil had also been revised in line with the latest fuel quality standards following consultation with the oil industry in order to discourage adulteration in petroleum products. Oil and gas industry regulator Ogra will not participate in commercial phase of the fuel marking programme, but it has agreed to perform its role at the implementation and monitoring stages.

According to a proposed mechanism, the actual cost of fuel marking may be included in the ex-depot sale price of kerosene oil through the monthly price revision.

The successful bidder has also agreed to offer a 3% price reduction for expanding the programme’s duration beyond the six-month trial period to one year.

Initially, the programme will be implemented for one year and then depending on results, it will be extended with the consent of Ogra or a fresh tender may be invited.

For the deregulated petroleum products, oil marketing companies may be directed to introduce and finance fuel marking from their profit margins.

Fuel marking plan to minimise oil adulteration

ISLAMABAD: Having failed to convince the prime minister and the finance minister to increase kerosene price, the petroleum ministry has decided to introduce the fuel marking programme with the support of oil marketing companies to minimise adulteration of petroleum products.

As a first step, the petroleum ministry and the oil industry have agreed to add “fuel marker” in the locally produced kerosene, which is suspected of being massively used to adulterate other products like petrol and high-octane blending component (HOBC) due to significant price differential between the fuels.

Fuel markers involve different detection methods, including clear and identifiable chemical colours and sophisticated molecular technology using chromatography-mass spectrometry technology and forensic laboratories that can detect fuel adulteration.

However, the process has been called into question by the Hydrocarbon Development Institute of Pakistan (HDIP) — a technical arm of the petroleum ministry — over the issues of transparency and procurement impropriety.

Documents suggest that a meeting, presided over by Petroleum Minister Shahid Khaqan Abbasi and attended by representatives by the oil industry and government organisations, observed that fuel adulteration was a major issue and should be tackled through the fuel marking programme.

To address issues like fuel marker’s nature, estimated volume, procurement, costs and installation of dosing and blending specifications etc, the meeting decided to involve a fuel marking company. The company is to be hired through a transparent manner through competitive bidding and will deal with all refineries, marketing companies and retail set-ups.

The minister constituted a committee, comprising representation from the regulator, all refineries and the HDIP and led by the Oil Companies Advisory Council (OCAC), to finalise standard bidding process and terms of agreement.

The meeting also decided that cost of the marker would be included in the ex-depot price with the approval of the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (Ogra).

The HDIP has now put on record that it “was not consulted or taken on board, at any stage of the bidding process, against the stipulation in the minutes and its first involvement began with the opening of single technical bid on June 2, 2017”.

On top of that, the HDIP has also said that reasons for the absence of other technical committee members, including Ogra, had not be recorded or documented.

“Technical role of HDIP must have been defined in the bidding documents,” it said.

The HDIP said that since the bidding process had been completed and the OCAC and the HDIP had already opened the technical bid document under instructions of the directorate of oil, it

should be ensured that competitive process was in accordance with the decision of the minister-led committee.

“Moreover, Ogra being member of the technical committee may also be involved in bid evaluation process (both technical and financial) so that the process could be completed,” it added.

An official said that the mixing of kerosene with petrol and HOBC had been a serious issue, causing significant revenue loss to the government and illegitimate earnings to unscrupulous market elements at the cost of consumers.

Kerosene is generally a tax-free product compared to almost 40-50 per cent taxes on other products like petrol, high speed diesel (HSD) and HOBC.

Therefore, kerosene has a negligible revenue impact because of its limited market. In contrast, petrol and HSD are two major products that generate most of oil revenue for the government because of their high taxes, besides their massive and yet growing consumption in the country.

For example, HSD sales across the country are now going beyond 800,000 tonnes per month against monthly consumption of around 600,000 tonnes of petrol. The sales of kerosene and LDO are generally less than 10,000 tonnes per month.

Interestingly, the Ministry of Petroleum and Ogra have been recommending for almost a year a substantial increase in the prices of kerosene and light diesel oil to minimise a huge price differential with petrol.

They argue that a Rs30 per litre price differential between petrol and the two other products is encouraging dishonest market operators to mix kerosene with petrol for higher profits and resulting in adulterated and poor quality petrol being sold in the market instead of higher grade (92RON) for which consumers pay.

The government has been rejecting these calls saying it wants to protect poor people.

Interestingly, kerosene is the only regulated petroleum product but unavailable at fixed rates anywhere in the country while all other products are deregulated and available reasonably within the price band announced by the government.

Subject: MEASURE FOR PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION IN PUBLIC
PROCUREMENT PROCESS FOR TRANSPARENCY AND

To plug the possible corruption holes during procurement process, National Accountability Bureau (NAB) under its Prevention Regime, as enshrined in section 33B and 33C of National Accountability Ordinance (NAO) 1999 read with Public Procurement Rules 2004, advises to abide by the following instructions, in order to ensure transparency in the public procurement process:

- a. Registration or enlistment of contractors on periodic basis a procurement agency is not needed under the Public Procurement Rules 2004 nor any charging of fee on this account is admissible. This practice should be stopped forthwith as it supports the Corrupt Practices of collusive/limited competition to favor the favorites.
- b. A procurement agency may adopt the process of pre-qualification of contractors to establish their ability to perform for a particular work; therefore enlistment of the contractors, as condition in pre-qualification is not required and cannot be imposed as condition for pre-qualification under Public Procurement Rules 2004.
- c. It is further required to completely specify the conditions and circumstances explained in rules 15 and 16 "pre-qualification of contractors and suppliers" and "pre-qualification process" of Public Procurement Rules 2004.

- d. All procuring agencies should make available the bidding or pre-qualification documents and other related communication in downloadable format, for any interested bidder or party, at their websites to use these documents for submitting bid(s) with admissible tender fee, if any, paid in bank as prescribes by procuring agency. This will break cartelization and collusive biddings. (Instructions under Prevention Regime of NAB)
- e. Mis-procurement declared and falling within Rule 50 of PP Rules 2004 at any stage shall be liable for cognizance by NAB under relevant Section of NAO 1999.

2. The above information be communicated to all subordinate offices responsible for procurement processes.

3. It is to inform that these instructions are issued after consultation with Public Procurement Regulatory Authority and with the approval of DG A&P NAB HQ / President Prevention Committee on Procurement, Projects and Auctions, constituted by Chairman NAB under Section 33C of NAO 1999, please.
