Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, District Coordination Officer/ Controller Civil Defence, Civil Defence Office, Pakpattan's Quotations/Tenders Notice for Bomb Disposal/Security Equipment.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Civil Defence Office, Pakpattan's Quotations/Tenders Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 4th September, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab Procurement Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "the number of items can be increased /decreased", whereas per rules, any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after the opening of the bid by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to PPRA 2014, Rule No. 59 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under:

59. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works:

(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:

(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement:

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No. 69, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

2. All quotations shall be received under PPRA Rules 2014 38(1).
3. Quotations must reach the Civil Defence Office up to 11:00 am of 20-09-2016 during office hours, which shall be opened the same day before the Special Purchase Committee and tenderers (in attendance) or their representatives in the DCO Office at 11:30 am. Tenders / quotations coming after 11:00 am shall not be acceptable.
4. The successful quotationer/tenderer shall have to deposit five percent of the total store value at the time of supply order as call deposit in favor of District Coordination Officer/Controller Civil Defence, Pakpattan.
5. Technical Proposals and Financial Proposals shall be sealed in separate envelopes.
6. The firm whose Technical Proposal is approved only its Financial Proposal shall be opened.
7. Quotationers shall deposit an earnest money of two percent of the total cost of the required store as call deposit.
8. All the supplied items shall be put before Special Purchase Committee/Senior Technical Officer. The payment of bill shall be made upon the satisfaction and recommendation of Committee.
9. Special Purchase Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders/quotations (estimates) in total.
