Sub: Violation of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, Director (Colleges)/ Convener Purchase Committee, Directorate of Education Colleges, Dera Ghazi Khan Division, Dera Ghazi Khan's Quotation/Tender Notice for Miscellaneous Items.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Directorate of Education Colleges, Dera Ghazi Khan's Quotation/Tender Notice published in daily "Dawn" on 7th December, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Punjab Procurement Rules 2014.

As per terms and condition No. 11, laid down in the advertisement, "Convener Purchase Committee reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof". However, as per Rule No. 35, PPRA 2014, the reason of rejection should be communicated to the bidders. Stated as under;

35. Rejection of Bids :- (1) *the procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal.*
(2) *the procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any bidder, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but shall not be required to justify those grounds.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 69, and with request to re-invite the quotation/tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The last date for receipt of quotations/tenders shall be up to 24-12-2016. Tenders will be opened the same day in the office of Director (Colleges) Dera Ghazi Khan in the presence of tenderers or their representatives at 02:00 pm. All further proceeding/purchase shall be conducted under PPRA Rules.
- Two percent of the tender value as earnest money/call deposit in the name of undersigned must accompany the tender.
- Purchase shall be conducted under PPRA Rules Punjab.
- Tender forms can be had from this office on payment of tender fee during working hours. Tender for each college and head will be separate. However, dispatch all quotations/tenders through official registered post/courier service to the undersigned (Director Colleges) Dera Ghazi Khan Division, Dera

- Ghazi Khan. Quotations/tenders by hand or any other source shall not be acceptable.
- It is mandatory for the firm that it delivers all the goods to the relevant college at his own expense.
- The tender, for which it is submitted, be mentioned on the envelope of each tender.
- Tenderer or his representative attach copy of identity card
- Tenderers will themselves be responsible for payment of all taxes and duties.
- Substandard items will be returned on the expense of the relevant firm. And further proceeding will be carried out after scrutiny.
- Further three percent earnest money will have to be deposited on getting the supply order.
- Convener Purchase Committee reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof. Against which no case/appeal/legal proceedings could be initiated in any court of law or authority.
- The tenderers to whom are acceptable the abovementioned terms & conditions can dispatch tenders for the standard goods present in stock.
- The rates of items should be acceptable by 30-06-2017.
- Firms must be Income Tax paying. Income Tax payment certificate, GST certificate for the year 2015-16 and an affidavit of not being blacklisted will have to be attached with the tender. Moreover, bring the photocopy of identity card of the firm's owner along in order to receive tender.
- Rates given in the quotation shall be final and no increase/decrease shall be acceptable afterwards.
- Successful tenderers will have to supply the required items within 30 days of the issuance of purchase order. Otherwise, earnest money will be forfeited and tender will be cancelled and the 2nd lowest tenderer will be issued supply order.
- Tenders not fulfilling the required terms & conditions or the ones received late shall neither be acceptable nor entertained.
- Goods will have to be supplied to the relevant colleges. The relevant committee shall conduct technical inspection as well as scrutiny as per the samples before the handing over of goods. Articles of the quality below the samples will not be acceptable.
- In case of any dispute, the decision of Convener Purchase Committee will be final which could not be challenged in any court of law/authority.
