**Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Maj Gen, Director of Health Services AK,
Rawalpindi's Tender Notice for Purchase of Bulk Medicines.**

This is with reference to Director of Health Services AK, Rawalpindi's Tender Notice, published in daily "The News" on 14th September, 2019. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per terms and condition No. 11 in the advertisement, "The Authority Competent (PC) reserves the right to accept/ reject any or all bids without assigning reasons". It is not complying with PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No. 33, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Stated as under:

33. Rejection of bids:- (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Invitation for Bids for Purchase of Bulk Medicines During FY 2019-2020

Directorate of Health Services AK invites sealed bids from pharmaceutical manufacturers/importers for the current financial year 2019-2020 for supply of bulk medicines for Hospitals, Dispensaries and RHCs. Bids are required to be received on 30 September 2019 at 1100 hrs complete in all respects in the office of the Directorate of Health Services/Secretary Health AJ&K the Chairman Purchase Committee (PC), 966/B Cobb Line Qasim Road Rawalpindi and will be opened on the same day at 1130 hrs in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to attend the subject meeting by the PC.

Terms & Conditions:

- Bids/ offers shall remain valid up to 30-06-2020.
- **Single stage— Two envelopes procedure, as per PPRA rules shall be applied**
- 5% of the total bid value shall be charged bid security in the shape of DD/Pay Order in the name of Director of Health Services AK, which will be mandatory to be deposited on finalization of contract prior to actual supply of items.
- Bidding documents can be obtained at the cost of Rs. 2000/- (Two Thousand-non-refundable) in shape of Bank Draft in the name of Director Health Services AK, 966/B Cobb Line Qasim Road Rawalpindi.
- Bidders shall be bound to follow the instructions appended in the Bidding Document.
- The delivery of drugs/medicines and miscellaneous items will be required at Central Medical Store Depot Sector H-9/1 (Opposite Margalla Railway Station) Islamabad.
- Minimum 80% shelf life of medicines from the date of supply of the medicines is required.
- The firms who supply the antibiotic drugs are also bound to supply the sufficient quantity of sensitivity discs of same item free of cost.
- All Taxes/Duties (if applicable) levied by Government of Pakistan will be deducted from the bills of suppliers under rules.
- Those firm/manufacturers are eligible for such supplies who are registered with Director General Defence Procurement (DGDP) or GHQ (Medical Directorate) and AJK Health Department.
- The competent authority (PC) reserves the right to accept/reject any or all bids without assigning reasons.
- Conditional/late bids will not be entertained.
- Bidding document will be issued on submission of written application.
