**Sub: Violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004, Director General (HR and Admin),
MEPCO, Multan's EOI Notice for Advertising Agencies.**

This is with reference MEPCO, Multan's EOI Notice, published in daily "The News" on 28th June, 2019. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per the term and condition No. 8 in the advertisement, "Cantonment Executive Officer reserves the right to reject or accept any or all applications without assigning any reason". It is not complying with PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No. 33, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Stated as under;

33. Rejection of bids:- (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the EOI under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
