





**HELD ON 11.09.2015**




2. Director (A&F), SPPRA briefed the committee that year-wise list of cases has been retrieved from the website of the Authority. The committee discussed the list in detail and decided as under:


- (1) The SPPRA will present a report to the committee for cases where the bids are yet to be opened, before opening of bids.
- (2) The sub-committee will start reviewing of the cases of 2015 from its next meeting.
- (3) The committee will also review the cases of minor observations since the inception of the Authority.
- (4) SPPRA shall write a letter to AG Sindh regarding violation of SPP Rules, 2010 (Amended 2013) on weekly basis, this shall also be placed on the website of the Authority.

3. The committee also discussed the issue regarding procurement of number plates by Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Department, Govt. of Sindh, Karachi. The committee was briefed about non-implementation of the decision of Review Committee. The committee endorsed the decision of the Review Committee and emphasized for implementation of the decision of Review Committee in letter & spirit and decided that all subsequent tenders No. INF/ KRY-1346/ 2015 and No.INF/ KRY-3041/ 2015 are hereby cancelled, null and void.
