Kindly refer the tender document for 'Lifting, Transportation and Disposal of Backlog of Garbage (Solid Waste) from DMC South Area to Landfill Sites of KMC'.

As discussed, TI-Pakistan has serious objections in this process, which is also being highlighted by media.


After the discussion held with you on 11th November, 2015 on this project, TI-Pakistan's recommendations are given as here under;

1. The tender should be advertised minimum for 15 days.
2. The estimated Backlog of garbage varies from 1.6 Million ton to 1.5 Million ton as stated by you, where as your estimate is about 0.8 Million ton.
3. The quantity variation is a cause of concern and therefore this project needs to be most transparent procurement.
4. The recommendation of TI-Pakistan is that the Blocks of garbage dumpes, that varies from 90-100 places in Six districts of Karachi should be tender on the lump sum basis, not on per ton basis, as no check can prevent collision in trips verifications.

Unless the above recommendations are incorporated in this tender by Solid Sindh Waste Management Board, TI-Pakistan would not participate as an observer in this procurement process.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
