Dear Sir,

This is with reference Deputy Commissioner, Khairpur's EOI Notice for Pre-Qualification, published in daily "Dawn" on 13th April, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation Sindh Procurement Rules 2010.

As per the advertisement, no Expression of Interest documents are issued, that include criteria for short listing; which is mandatory requirement of Sindh Procurement Rules 2010, Rule No. 73 (2) (d). The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

73. Request for Expression of Interest

(2) Request for Expression of Interest shall contain the following information:

- (a) name and address of procuring agency;*
- (b) appropriate description of the assignment providing scope of the intellectual and professional services required;*
- (c) deadline and place of the submission of Request for Expression of Interests;*
- (d) criteria for short listing; and*
- (e) any other information that the procuring agency may deem appropriate to disseminate at this stage.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 56, and with request to re-invite the EOI for pre-qualification under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
