
**SUBJECT: VIOLATION OF SPPRA RULES IN PROCESS OF RS.500.00 MILLION
PROJECTS CONSTRUCTION OF FLY OVER AT HABIB BANK
CHOWRANGI SITE AREA, KARACHI**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject noted above and to inform that this Authority received complaint regarding non-compliance of SPP Rules, 2010 from M/s Maqbool Associates (Pvt) Limited Karachi and complaint from M/s Transparency International – Pakistan in the procurement of the Project “Construction of Fly Over at Habib Bank Chowrangi SITE Area, Karachi” and this Authority called comments from the procuring agency i.e. M/s SITE Limited, Karachi.

2. On the recommendation of the SPPRA Board members, the matter was referred to the sub-committee of SPPRA Board constituted for non-compliance of SPP Rules, 2010. The sub-committee held a series of meeting to hear the procuring agency and examine/ review the record and clarification received from the procuring agency. While, examining/ reviewing the case, the committee observed that the procuring agency has not observed Rule-17, 31(6) 41(3), 41(8), 45 and Rule-50. Besides, the procuring agency also changed the price of lowest bid from Rs.504.57 million to Rs.649.99 million a huge variation of Rs.145.42 million on the pretext of arithmetic corrections. After discussion the committee unanimously decided that since the procuring agency and the consultants have failed to provide plausible clarification and justification specially regarding the huge arithmetical errors, hence, the matter may be referred to the competent forum for declaration of mis-procurement in terms of Rule-56 of Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010.

3. Accordingly, the matter was discussed in the 25th meeting of the SPPRA Board, which endorsed the decision of sub-committee and unanimously decided that the case shall be referred to the Anti-corruption Establishment for necessary action as per Rules, as provided under Rule-56 of SPP Rules, 2010. A brief of the case along with relevant record is **enclosed**.

4. In view of the above, the Enquiries and Anti-corruption Establishment is requested to take the necessary action as per rules under intimation to this Authority.
