Sub: Violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010, Deputy Director Food, Regional Food Directorate, Sukkur Region's Tender Notice for Transportation of Wheat & Bardana etc.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Regional Food Directorate, Sukkur Region's Tender Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 20th February, 2017. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010.


As per advertisement, "Quantity shown in the bidding documents which will be increased or decreased on the basis of requirement", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to SPPRA Rules 2010, Rule No. 16 (e), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under:

*16. Alternate Methods of Procurements (1) A procuring agency may utilize following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works, namely:-
(e) Repeat Orders – means procurement of additional quantities of the item(s) from the original contractor or supplier, where, after the items originally envisaged for the project or scheme have been procured through open competitive bidding, and such additional quantities of the same item(s) of goods or works are needed to meet the requirements of the project or scheme;*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 32(A), and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

TENDER NOTICE

Sealed Bids are invited from Firms Registered with Tax Authorities (Federal & Provincial) for Transportation of Wheat & Bardana etc. within District / Other District (Within Region) & Other Region for the Crop 2016-17 (F.Y. 2017-18).

Bidding Documents can be collected from the Office of THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOOD SUKKUR REGION SUKKUR, NAWA GOTH SHIKARPUR ROAD, CITY FOOD GODOWNS, SUKKUR, from **20th February, 2017 to 8th March, 2017** during office hours on payment of tender fee Rs. 2,000/- (For each district). Bidding documents can also be downloaded from SPPRA website www.pprasindh.gov.pk and submitted along with the tender fee.

The Bids shall be received back on **09th March, 2017 upto 2:00 PM** at the Office of THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOOD SUKKUR REGION SUKKUR, NAWA GOTH SHIKARPUR ROAD, CITY FOOD GODOWNS, SUKKUR (By hand or through courier service) and shall be opened on the same day at **3:00 PM**, in presence of the parties or their representatives, who wish to be present. If **09th March, 2017** is declared as public holiday / general riot the tenders will be received / opened on the next working day at the same time and venue. In case NIT remains un-responded by the above date, the next date of opening will be **28th March, 2017** at 3:00 PM and last date of issuance of tenders will be **27th March, 2017**.

No tender form shall be issued on the day of opening of the tenders.

For tendering the following terms and conditions may also be fulfilled and required to submit following documents / certificates.

1. The parties shall fill in tender form for each District (Within District / Other District) (within Region) separately. The other terms and conditions, details of work / routes showing quantity of wheat to be shifted and amount of security deposit are shown in the bidding document.
2. Bid Security 5% of Bid price should be submitted along with Bid in shape of Pay Order in favor of "The Deputy Director Food Sukkur Region, Sukkur", issued by any scheduled bank of Pakistan.
3. The bid security shall be forfeited to the Government, if the bidder withdraws his bid after opening and before the expiry of the bid validity period or fails to sign the contract if the bid is accepted.
4. Conditional bid and bid without bid security shall not be considered.
5. Quantity shown in the bidding documents which will be increased or decreased on the basis of requirement.
6. The bidders shall submit their bids in a single package containing two separate envelopes. Each envelope shall contain separately the financial

proposal and technical proposal. The first envelope shall be marked as "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" and second as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" in bold and legible letter to avoid confusion under the relevant provision of Rule 46(2) of SPP Rules, 2010 (Amended 2013).

7. Copy of GST / Income Tax Certificates, Registration with Sindh Revenue Board must be accompanied with the bid.
8. Any contractor involved in misappropriation or wheat trading shall not be entitled to participate in tendering process.
9. The other terms and conditions as envisaged under SPPRA Rules-2010 (Amended-2013) will govern on these contracts.
10. The procuring agency may reject all or any bid at any time prior to acceptance of a bid, subject to relevant provisions of SPP Rules, 2010 (Amended-2013).

11. REQUIREMENT FOR TECHNICAL PROPOSAL:

- i. Three year's experience in transportation field.
- ii. Performance Certificate, required from those Transport Contractors who have already awarded contract in Sukkur Food Region during last FY year 2016-17. Further, those Transport Contractors who have awarded contractors in other Region of Food Department viz: Karachi, Mirpurkhas, Larkana & Hyderabad, they should produce the performance certificate issued by the concerned Deputy Director Food.
- iii. The transporter is expected to provide source(s) of their own transportation agency in case they do not have personal transport.
- iv. That contractor shall not be entitled to participate who owns or gets involved into more than one agency as sole proprietor / investor.
- v. Complete profile and history of company.
- vi. Copy of GST / Income Tax Certificates, Registration with Sindh Revenue Board, Professional Tax Certificate from Excise & Taxation Department must be accompanied with the bid.
- vii. Affidavit as firm / company is not defaulter and is not in litigation with Food Department, Government of Sindh.
- viii. Bank Statement for last three years of the firm / company.
- ix. Further details of requirements/terms and conditions are mentioned in Bidding Documents.
