**Sub: Violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010, Complaint against Works & Services Dept. Office of Executive Engineer Provincial Buildings Division Mirpurkhas, Tender for 'Up-Gradation of Rural Health Centre /Basic Health Unit and Renovation/Repair of Staff Quarters'.**

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint against Works & Services Dept. office of Executive Engineer Provincial Buildings Division Mirpurkhas, Tender for Up-Gradation of Rural Health Centre /Basic Health Unit and Renovation/Repair of Staff Quarters. Published on 03-05-2017 on SPPRA website and advertised in daily 'Messenger' (English) dated 16-02-2017, 'Sarmaya' (Urdu) dated 15-02-2017 and 'Pereh' (Sindhi) dated 15-02-2017 ([http://pprasindh.vector-computing.com/?tender\\_list%5Bpage%5D=68](http://pprasindh.vector-computing.com/?tender_list%5Bpage%5D=68)).

Also Transparency International Pakistan refers to the news article published on 25-04-2017 in daily 'Nai Baat', related to corruption of Rs. 32 Caror for the above said tender. The news article alleged that the contract of Taluka hospital building has been awarded without tender process and work order (Copy is enclosed for your ready reference) (Annexure A).

The above mentioned tenders are in violation of Sindh Procurement Rules 2010, Rule No.17 (2) (4). As the NIT should be published in at least three widely circulated leading daily newspapers. Stated as under;

***17. Methods of Notification and Advertisement***

***(2) The advertisement in the newspapers shall appear in at least three widely circulated leading dailies of English, Urdu and Sindhi languages.***

***(3) The notice inviting tender shall contain the following information:***

***(a) name, postal address, telephone number(s), fax number, e-mail address (if available) of the procuring agency;***

***(b) purpose and scope of the project;***

***(c) schedule of availability of bidding documents, submission and opening of bids, mentioning place from where bidding documents would be issued, submitted and would be opened;***

***(d) amount and manner of payment of tender fee and bid security;***

***(e) any other information that the procuring agency may deem appropriate to disseminate at this stage;***

***(4) In cases, the procuring agency has its own website; it shall also post all advertisements concerning procurement on that website as well;***



DG, NAB is requested to kindly examine the complaint and if found genuine take necessary action against all those officers involved in corrupt practices and re-tender the above NIT so that all the eligible interested bidders may participate in the tender to allow widest possible competition.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
