**Sub: Complaints regarding improper recruitment procedure in  
Jacobabad Institute of Medical Sciences (JIMS)**

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a number of complaints regarding improper recruitment procedures in Jacobabad Institute of Medical Sciences (JIMS).


The complainants have alleged that two politically influential people from Jacobabad were present in the interviewing panel, a Member of the National Assembly (MNA) and a Member of the Provincial Assembly (MPA), which is reported to be the primary cause of the following concerns as mentioned by the complainants.

1. The recruitment process did not include a written test or screening process
2. Applicants were asked irrelevant and unprofessional questions
3. Candidates were selected prior to the interview
4. Decision making based on favoritism

TI-Pakistan would greatly appreciate if you would kindly look into this matter, and if found genuine/correct, take appropriate action to address this matter, so that the citizens may get justice.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
